



Re-Integration, School Visits and Graduations

Bridge Road School engages in strong collaboration between families, students and the community of Home Schools. These partnerships support student learning and enable an effective reintegration process. The Bridge Road School program is a reintegration program between local Home Schools and a specialist educational setting. Bridge Road School's reintegration procedures focus on student attendance and a collaborative approach to re-engaging, disengaged students whose learning is at risk.

Staff from Bridge Road School, both Teaching and School Learning Support Officers visit Home Schools weekly. Within a fortnight all student Home Schools have been supported. School visits are an opportunity for Bridge Road Staff to work side by side with their Home School colleagues and improve practice. This support builds the capacity of staff working in Home Schools to reengage disengaged learners and ultimately improve their learning outcomes. This program is continually monitored and evaluated to ensure it has the best outcomes for our students and the Home School Colleagues. Feedback from Home Schools indicates that the school visit program is a necessary and highly valuable program provided by Bridge Road Staff to support their professional development in managing complex students in mainstream settings.
