The Bridge Road Buddies were introduced to students in 2019. These behaviour management strategies were designed to help students build resilience and become safe, respectful and responsible learners.



Each Buddy is named after a strategy that can be used by students when faced with challenging situations.

The Buddy Program is now a fundamental part of Bridge Road School and is promoted during class, assemblies and debrief. Staff discuss with students

which strategies they find helpful.

Students are encouraged to wear Buddy bracelets as a reminder to use the strategies throughout the day.
