
## BRIDGE ROAD SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

Our daily fitness program continues and the children's fine and gross motor skills are improving steadily. This program commences our day at the school - so much learning is taking place - joining in, playing fairly, taking turns, being cooperative, improving skills and personal bests etc.... Nutrition goes hand in hand with fitness - we ask for your support when packing food

for the children each day - please do not include brightly coloured soft drinks and too many overly salty or sweet items - we realize too, that some children eat very little at school but we do try to get them to take food from their bags to eat. We have fruit, cut into small pieces every lunch time - the children leave their games and run to line up when they see the fruit leaving the cottage!

Next term in Weeks 5 and 6 we will be attending swimming lessons for 2 weeks at Victoria Park Pool. Prior to this the students will be involved in a Water Safety Program.

There will be a football workshop over 3 weeks as well next term.
